In its continuing effort to reach out to the elderly in southeast Michi-gan, Botsford General Hospital has opened a specialized mental health

The facility, specifically designed for patients ages 55 and older, is on the fourth floor of the Farmington Hills hospital. It will accommodate up to 25 patients for short-term treatment of acute episodes of illness.

A multi-disciplinary treatment team, including psychiatrists, clinical psychologists, a program director, clinical nurse specialist, activities therapists, social workers and psychiatric nursing staff will be a second to the formalities core with the attress of mental filmes.
