A. Perhaps these affluent but naive directors should be reminded of the liabilities attendant with serving on a board of directors of any corporation, be it for profit or not for profit. Ask these directors whether they would run their own businessess or professions without the benefit of legal counsel, or certified public accountant and or managerial assistance and consultation where necessary.



Remind them also that they are personally liable for the acts or omissions of the board of directors of the association and they can be sued and held liable for their misdeeds, actions or omissions. Remind them also that they have fiduciary reponsibility to operate in the best interests of the association and that their misguided pentriousness could come back to haunt them.

Q. We have purchased a building on a land contract and wish to close on it in the near future. 
For the competition exhibition, Becker selected 41 prints by 33 Michigan artists. "I selected the prints in this exhibition according to my perceived sense of structure and


