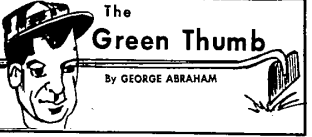

The Green Thumb

Geranium care: If your geraniums are tall and gangly, I'd take cuttings from them now. If rooted now, they'll make dandy plants by the time Memorial Day rolls around.

If allowed to grow without any pruning, the mother plants will be tree-size and fill your entire kitchen.

These cuttings can be three or four inches long, and the cut can be made anywhere on the branch. Take all leaves off lower half (they'll only rot) and insert the cuttings into your favorite rooting material.

Clean sharp sand, vermiculite or perlite, or just plain tap water are used for rooting. If you use rooting materials make sure holes are in the bottom of the pot or box to prevent rotting. Place cuttings into the material to a depth of one inch to hold cuttings upright. Cuttings are well watered and kept moist, but NOT SOGGY.

An ordinary clay pot — six to eight inches across makes a good starting "greenhouse" for your favorite plants. Fill the pot with perlite, sand or vermiculite, insert cuttings, water them well, then place a plastic bag over pot and all to reduce water loss, and to hasten rooting. Keep cuttings out of direct sunlight, and they'll root in three or four weeks.

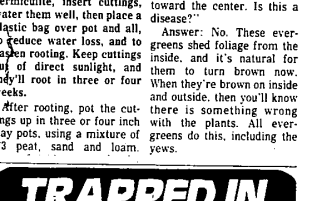
After rooting, pot the cuttings up in three or four inch clay pots, using a mixture of 1/3 peat, sand and loam.

GLADS AGAIN: A reader asks us why we do not refer to glads as gladioli, or gladioli. Here's the reason: Because home gardeners (and professionals) have referred to the plural as gladioli, gladioli, gladioluses, the North American Gladiolus Council decided to end this confusion and decreed that the plural of glads and the singular be referred to as gladiolus.

So, one glad is gladiolus, and more than one is also gladiolus. This may violate the laws of latin but it certainly does a lot to prevent a lot of confusion.

GREEN THUMB CLINIC: Our arborvitae evergreens have a lot of brown leaves toward the center. Is this a disease?

Answer: No. These evergreens shed foliage from the inside, and it's natural for them to turn brown now. When they're brown on inside and outside, then you'll know there is something wrong with the plants. All evergreens do this, including the yews.
