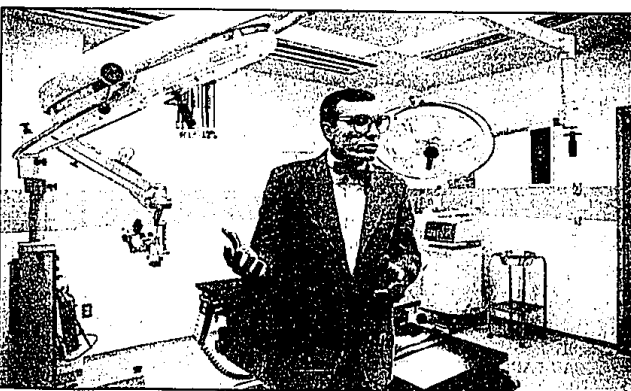

## Sinai satellite Hospital opens new outpatient surgical center in the Hills

**S**CHEDULING IS under way now to receive patients for Sinai Hospital's newest satellite in Farmington Hills.

Target date for the opening of Sinai Outpatient Surgery Center, at 28500 Orchard Lake Road, is Monday, Feb. 1. The facility occupies the first two floors of the Louis and Vivian Berry Health Center.

"About 50 percent of all surgery done now can be handled on an outpatient basis," said Dick Ayscove, who is director of Ambulatory Surgery for Sinai Health Services and began working toward the opening of the Farmington Hills center about two years ago.

"In another few years 80 percent of all surgery will be outpatient surgery. It's a national trend. Michigan has just been a little slow in the process," he said.

The center offers a complete range of ambulatory surgical procedures under local or general anesthesia. It is equipped with four operating rooms, a laboratory, X-ray facilities and recovery rooms.

"It's all state of the art equipment," Ayscove said. "We've kept up with the new technology all the time we were planning, building, ordering, and we plan to keep keeping up as long as we're here."

GYNECOLOGICAL, orthopedic, urology, eye, ear, nose and throat surgeries will be performed in the center, along with "the general

lumps and bumps surgeries" Ayscove said.

"It's all top quality, designed for the comfort and convenience of the patients and whatever is needed for recovery."

"Children receive extra special treatment here. All of the children's areas were designed with extra special care," he said. "Children make up a great percentage of our patients."

Youngsters have their own waiting rooms and recovery areas equipped with television and videos,

boats to climb in and a salt water aquarium, all with a nautical theme.

For adults the theme is art deco, with a lot of marble and glass.

Ayscove called the new center "a natural outgrowth to meet patients' needs."

In addition to Sinai's primary care center in Detroit, the hospital operates a building of professional offices adjacent to the main hospital, a building of doctors' offices in Bingham Farms, and a psychiatric and rehabilitation center in West Bloomfield.
