Buying an out-of-state condominium sometimes poses additional potential legal problems necessifating

A. It is impossible for me to tell you whether, in fact, you are paying the proper assessment without reviewing the condominium documents and, in particular, the condominium master deed, which sets forth the basis upon which assessments will be paid by the respective

ments will be part by the traspecture co-owners.

The master deed must establish some criteria for establishing per-centages of value, which in 1977, was the basis by which assessments were to be allocated among various co-owners. The developer may have made the assessments equal if the

percentages of the value were equal, notwithstanding the variances of square footage of the units. You should have an attorney review the condominium documents, have him provide you with an opinion and, if the board is wrong, bring it to the attention of the board of directors immediately. 
#### Parents are invited to learn about Suzuki

The orientation session is 90 long. Parents are asked to attend without their children. For more informa-tion, call the Institute of Music and Dance at 831-2870.








