

Oakway's scholarship winners spotlighted

Winners of the Oakway Symphony Orchestra Young Artist Competition will be presented in concert with the orchestra at 3 p.m. Sunday, Feb. 28, in the Activities Center in Madonna College, Livonia.

Scholarship funds for the winners, four in number, are being provided by the Arts Foundation of Michigan, the DiBlasi Memorial Vocal Fund and the Oakway Symphony. They total \$1,600.

First-prize winner Kenneth Tarver is a tenor and student at the Oberlin Conservatory in Ohio. Named the DiBlasi scholar, he will receive \$600 from the Arts Foundation. He will perform works by Handel, Massenet and Mozart. He is a native Detroit.

A University of Michigan School of Music student, Laura L. Dahl, is second-prize winner and will be awarded \$400 at the concert. A pianist, she will perform the first movement of the piano concerto by Robert Schumann.

THIRD PRIZES OF \$300 each will be awarded to two music school students at the University of Michigan. Winners are Kristine Schreiber, a clarinet student of Fred Ormand, and James Wilson, cellist, a former student of Carol Bundera.

Schreiber will perform the "Premiere Rhapsody" by Claude Debussy, and Wilson will perform "Variations on a Theme of Rocco," by Tchaikovsky.

In addition to the solo numbers, the orchestra, under the baton of its conductor Francesco DiBlasi, will perform the "Overture to Prometheus" by Beethoven.

Judges of the competition were Jeanette Dagger, professor of voice at Wayne State University, and Douglas Morrison, director of the Scandinavian Symphony of Detroit. Winners were selected from a field of 33 competitors.

Concert tickets are \$8.50 and \$6 for seniors and students. They may be purchased at Madonna College, Hammill Music in Livonia, Executive Office Supply in Farmington or by calling 353-9128.
