The piano and violin literature is among the blessed areas in chamber music. Most masters have generously contributed to it, to the delight of listeners and performers alike. And masterful works require masterful performers to fully explore and reveal their treasures.

The show of respect and tribute to former teachers is too rarely demonstrated by those who climbed the ladder of success. I wish this would take place more often.
