Record number of prisoners are jammed into county jails

Oakland County's jall population reached a record high Saturday, and unless current trends are reversed the jall will likely be jammed to capacity even after a 200-bed addition is opened in December.

The jall population at the Pontiac facility has been averaging more than 600 for a mort of the second order. The jall meets the guidelines by placing prisoners temporarily in a gym or in holding cells.

"You have to be careful with numbers when dealing with prisoners. There are a lot of unknown factors. This is an entirely mobile population. A lot come in and a lot go out," Nichols said, pointing to immates who spend a night or less in jail and then are released after paying fines or posting bonds.
"We could face overcrowding (in the new facility) if we don't take some additional steps," Nichols said, but certain options are open, such as double bunking in the new facility. More than double bunking, however, may be necessary to relieve future overcrowding.
The total number of immates now in the jail system — those in the Oakland County jail as well as those who are in satellite locations or in county jails elsewhere — exceeded 1,100 for the first time in February.


