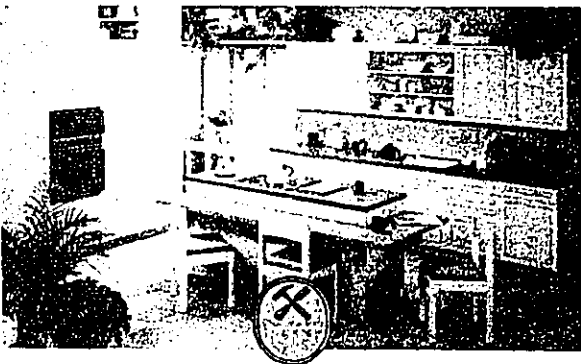
- Good Directions Inc., from Stamford, Conn., which specializes in weathervanes, sundials, garden signs and small roof-top domes.

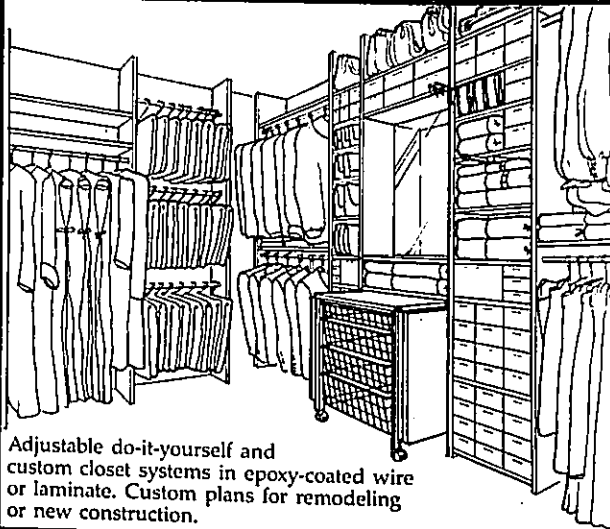
