value of the renter household's T-bill.


At the end of 10 years, the home owner has paid \$15,347 less in federal taxes; and his home has appreciated to

Were he to sell the home and buy another more expensive residence, his gain would be tax deferred. The cash value of the T-bill would be \$17,874 at the end of the 10 years and would be taxable.
