THE COMPANY was founded in 1938 by brothers Fred, Louis and John Elias. Today it employs 17,000 persons statewide. Its annual sales are approximately \$425 million.

The company has several divisions. Along with Big Boy Restaurants, it also operates a limited menu, fast growing, fast food chain, Top Hat Restaurants, now located only in Detroit

In addition, the company operates a stadium and area division that provides food, programs, souvenirs and wearing apparel to the Silverdome, Michigan International Speedway and Championship Auto Racing Teams network of race tracks.

It also services Tiger Stadium with food products as well as the Huron-Clinton Metroparks. It manages the Main Event Restaurant at the Silverdome, and the Silverdome Banquet Fa-





Homes are shipped with all drywall and painting completed and all kitchens, bath-rooms and carpeting installed, he said. Some of the standard features of Hecka-

Some of the standard features of Hecka-man Homes include Merillat cabinets. Armstrong carpeting and vinyl Ownes-Corning sidewalls and ceiling insulation, Andersen windows, copper plumbing and eight-foot ceilings, 200-amp service and
