Hills was honored by the Michigan State University chapter of the Society of Women Engineers.

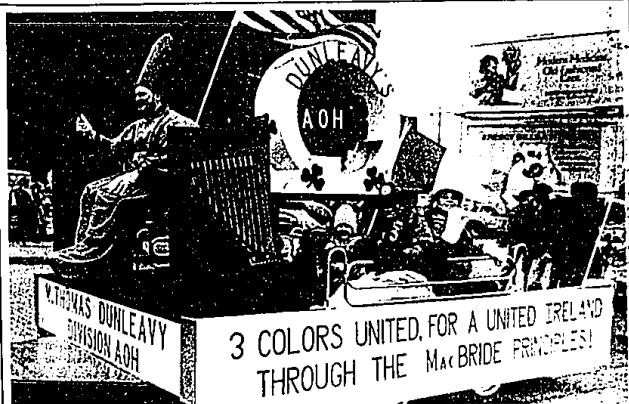
The engineering arts major was recognized for having the highest grade point average of all the senior SWE members in her major.
