

As Samuel Johnson once said, "The next best thing to knowing something is knowing where to find it."

THE PROCESS of finding the right consultant begins by identifying what type of assistance is needed, when it is needed, for what length of time, and the funds to be spent for consulting services. Generally speaking, consultants charge anywhere from \$25 per hour

up to \$5,000 per day. Locating poten-tial consulting candidates should be based on the recommendations of others to include business associates,

others to include business associates, chambers of commerce, industry associations, other consultants and clients.


