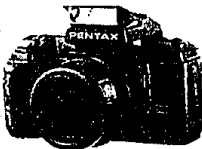
Ferrer, a senior majoring in mass communications, serves as producer for his team.

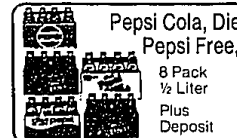

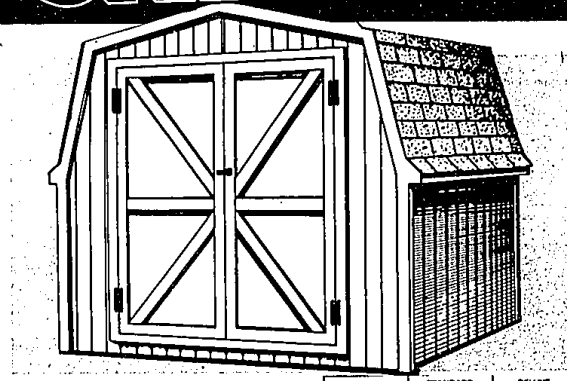
