

# OU trains on health ethics, job hunting

Free public lectures on the ethical issues related to high technology and health care will be offered Friday and Saturday, April 8-9, at Oakland University near Rochester.

Professor Anne J. Davis will speak both days on "Integrating Science, Technology and Human Values Applications in Research, Health and Health Care."

The presentations are sponsored by the OU School of Nursing and the GTE Foundation lectureship program. Davis will speak at 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. Friday, April 8, in the Gold rooms of the Oakland Center.

Presentations are designed for health care professionals and the public.

The Saturday, April 9, session runs from 8 a.m. through 1 p.m. in 202 O'Dowd Hall. It will cover some of the same issues but is designed for the general public as well as professionals.

Davis has returned from China where she has assisted the Chinese in establishing professional ethics committees. She is with the School of Nursing at the University of California, San Francisco.

Fundamentals of using the IBM

Lotus 1-2-3 classes are taught from 9 to 12:30 Saturdays, May 7 to June 4. They are designed for beginners from workplace and home. Tuition of \$150 includes an instructional package for post-class reference.

Career specialists Judith Hoppin of the Continuum Center staff and Rosemary Doyle, associate staff, will lead the workshops. "First class qualifications are not enough anymore," said Hoppin. "You're in for a shock if you think your resume will get you the job all by itself."


