Israelis' love of land evident in Yakir show

The quality of accessibility carries over into the work of sculptor, Ahron Bezalel. "Creation and Exodus," a rounded, bronze three-piece pan-el, tells the story its title implies. The story can be understood while walking around the piece.

Bezalel makes the viewer part of this ongoing story that has been told and retold. Bezalel, who lives in a tiny village outside Jerusalem near an ancient monastery, juxtaposes his highly sophis-

ticated uses of brass, bronze and wood with sub-jects from the Old Testament. His "Biblical Caravan" is especially fine.

BENJAMIN LEVY'S whimsteal "Blue Lady" leaps into the 1980s without disturbing the works near it. Slightly surreal, the lady with hair that matches the pattern on her dress looks out at the world with a doll-like expression. She seems to be telling us that life is a droll aflair. Actor Dustin Holfiman owns one of the Blue La-

dies, and it's easy to see the influence of Paris (where Levy presently lives) in this work.

Levy's "Couple With a Parrot," another surreabout accessible work, uses the device of a window to bring the rolling bitls into a bedroom where a half-unde wife and her husband regard a parrot with amazement.

Zigi Ben-Hajim's large silkscreen features green, as many of the works do. Green is the color of hope, of land in bloom. Orl Reisman's "Standing Woman" is a blaze of orange, black

and green. Faridah's oils are filled with green. Farideh, a protege of Zaritsky, brings this 'rich show full circle with her palnting, 'The Hills of Judea.' The verve of the lines, the surety of her brushstrokes, the green of the hills is all about hope, glory and reflection.
