Family remembers great, great aunt on Mother's Day

The Fred Jarvis family in Farmington Hills celebrates Mother's Day much like most American families do, but always remembering that it was one of their ancestors whose dogged determination evoked the national observance.

Anna Jarvis — sometimes referred to as the spinster mother of Mother's Day — grew up in West Virginia where she began her crusade to have one day a year set aside to honor the mothers of the nation. England had been celebrating Mother's Day since 1872.

The first observance of Mother's Day was in a Methodist Church in Grafton, W.Va., on May 12, 1907, the Sunday closest to the anniversary of Anna Jarvis's mother's death.

But it wasn't until 1924, after letters, personal appeals and perseverance that she persuaded President Woodrow Wilson to declare the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day. Anna Jarvis, who was never a mother also started the tradition of wearing a carnation on that day.

The family was well known in West Virginia and many of them lived in Jarvisville. Fred Jarvis's father was the first to leave West Virginia and for a while the family lived in Marietta, Ohio. His family has been living in Farmington Hills for 10 years. Jarvis has three children, Fred James Jarvis III, Delann Jarvis and Julie Willis.
