

## condo queries Röbert M. Meisner

Q. One of the board members has asked me, as an attorney, whether or not the association's attorney was doing the right thing when he started a foreclosure action against a convery joining the first mortgage of record in the lawsuit. A. The condominium statute gives the first mortgage holder of record priority in regard to the claim of the association for back assessments. where the so-calido "cheap lawyer"
may actually be causing the association to expend more money unnecessarily.

Q. The developer of our condominum project claims to be selling units "as is" even through he is doing extensive renovations. The salesperson has indicated that these renovations will be of top quality and will be all encompassing throughout the condonitation. I am wondering whether to believe the developer's sales agent, Do you have any recommendations?

A. There is an implied warranty that the renovations will be done in a workmanlike and satisfactory fashion. To the extent possible, do not accept any documents which relightly. Also, confirm the representations made by the sales agent in writing if at all possible. You may be best advised to look at another endominum project under the circumstances.




