

Women's Foundation to honor 11 artists

The Michigan Women's Foundation will honor 11 Michigan women artists at a special celebration at 7 p.m. Wednesday, May 25, at McGreggor Conference Center, Wayne State University, Detroit.

The event will be hosted by Paula Blanchard, director of Telstate, MSU, East Lansing, and Carmen Harlan, news anchor, WDIV-TV, Detroit.

The program will include an exhibit of the artists' work and the Michigan premiere of the film, "Hearts and Hands," depicting the role women and their quilts played in the movements and events of the 19th century.

The artists who were chosen to be honored from statewide nominations are: Aviva Robinson, painting, Bloomfield Hills; Sue Linburg, sculpture, Huntington Woods; Mollie Fletcher, fibers, Detroit; Susanne Stephenson, clay, Ann Arbor; and Lynne Avadenka, graphics, Huntington Woods.


Artists selected by the Foundation for outstanding contributions to the arts are: Dr. Gladie Taylor, art leadership, Detroit; Nora Mendoza, cultural awareness, West Bloomfield; Cyril Miles, community outreach, Detroit; Lillian Wolock Elliott, Berkeley, Cal., nationally recognized artist; Shirley Woodson, art activist, Detroit; and Mary Schaefer, Heart and Hands quilting award, Flint.
