## Appointments OK'd for appeals board, planning commission

The city of Farmington has two new planning commissioners and a new zoning board of appeals member, after council action taken May 2.

Southfield attorney Darla Killinger and sales support manager Anthony Smolek will serve on the planning commission. New to the city's board of zoning appeals is Richard Peters. All are Farmington residents.

Killinger replaces Harry Lapham Jr., who resigned from a 3-year term that expires in June 1989. Killinger is a nine-year resident of Farmington, and specializes in environmental, corporate and real estate law. She works for the firm of Levin, Levin, Garvett and Dill.

Smolek takes over a seat vacated by Charles Bridges Jr. His term expires next month. Smolek was appointed to fill the vacancy, plus appointed to an additional three-year term which expires in June 1991.

Smolek and his family have lived in the Farmington community for most of the past eight years. He is a manager for Digital Equipment Corp., and has also worked in a variety of jobs, including as a consultant, account manager and data processing coordinator.

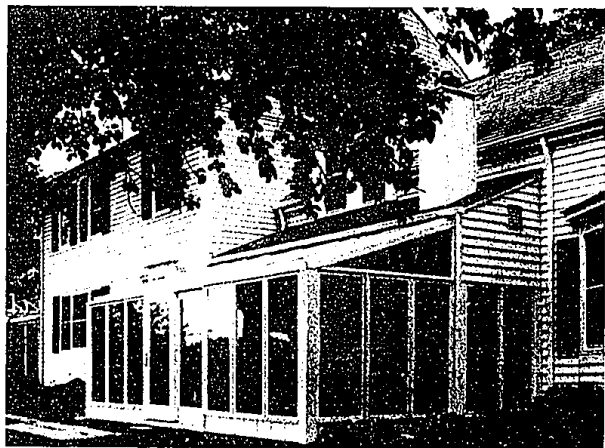

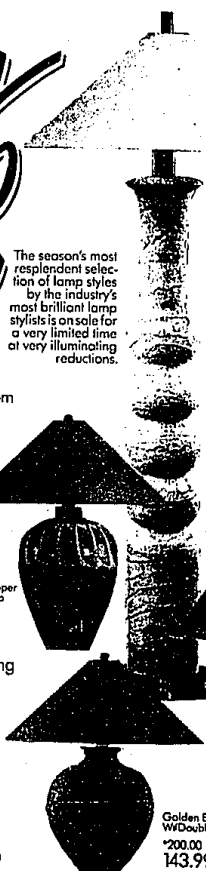
