## Get rid of mildew

Summer is here and excessive moisture is a real problem. Because we have more appliances and gadgest that create moisture, and our houses are so airtight, the moisture has no place to escape.

According to Elaine Glasser, home economist for Cooperative Extension Service of Oakland County, several products control mildew, but use them with care. Chlorine bleach, for instance, is good for concrete floors and tild walls but harmful to certain fabrics. And never mix chlorie with ammonia; the resulting fumes can be dangerous.

It is not enough just to get rid of mildew. It will return if you don't lake care of the problem of dampness, warmth, lack of ventilation, dirt and a lack of light.
