Co-op opens for 4- and 5-year-olds

Mayfair Co-op Nursery, at 30450 Farmington Road, will open for classes Wednesday, Sept. 14. Openings are available for 4 and 5 year olds in afternoon sessions.

Mayfair offers the preschool child the opportunity to participate in an environment of play and learning while gradually breaking the bond from home through parent participation in the classroom. Parents also have the opportunity to share in their child's early education and observe the transition from home to school.

Mayfair is the only co-op nursery school in Farmington and Farmington Hills and is about to begin its 34th year of operation. Maxine Flagg, a state certified early childhood teacher, has been at Mayfair for 11 years and will assume the role of director and full-time instructor in September.

Additional services are available at Mayfair that can allow families previously unable to participate in a

co-op the opportunity to now do so. A "paid parent option" allows a working parent to hire another Mayfair parent to cover a portion of their assigned participation days. A significant other (grandparent, babysitter, etc.) may also work in lieu of the working parent. For families with younger siblings, Mayfair provides on-site baby-sitting co-opera-

tively staffed by participating parents.

Also available at Mayfair is a non-co-operative prekindergarten enrichment class, which meets Tuesday and Thursday afternoons and is geared toward the older preschool child who can benefit from additional classroom experience.

Openings are available in the co-op class meeting Monday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons for 4 and 5 year olds and the non-co-op class for 4 and 5 year olds, which meets Tuesday and Thursday afternoons.
