LET THE cold winds blow. Bring
on the pouring rain. Your

"Even those homes that are in over-
all good condition still require a cer-
tain amount of upkeep," says Thomas

"The more you keep up with the

you'll be surprised with a major ex-
pense down the line."

Finney recommends that home own-
ers perform a routine check of the
house — the exterior and interior —
each fall.

Start by examining gutters and
downspouts. Check to see if any sec-
tions are misaligned or have pulled
away from the edge of the roof. Clear
debris from gutters. While you are up
there, repair or replace broken brack-
ets and patch holes in the troughs.

Consider installing gutter guards.
