Bolcom wrote the fantasia for the 1986 Mozart Week in Salzburg, He chose an Italianate, operatic style of composition to evoke the feeling of Mozart, using Mozart's Sinfonia Concertante in E-flat Major as a model.

Babini has held his position since 1960. He began his career as a

youngster giving recitals in his na-tive Brazil and South America. He was a student of the great cellist Pa-blo Casals and appeared as soloist at the Casals Festival and in recital

William Bolcom is a serious composer who also enjoys per-forming music on the lighter side with his wife, Joan Morris, mezzo-soprano. with Jesus Maria Sanroma. He is also an active soloist and recording artist and completed his latest recording last summer with the Lon-don Philharmonic.

Mishnaevaky Joined the Detroit Symphony Orchestra in 1988 after spending several years in New York as a Chamber musician, recitalist and orchestral performer on both viola and vola. Mishnaevaky emigrated to the United States in 1973, after studying violin in his native Moscow. At the suggestion of Isaac Stern, he took up the viola and studied with Stern and William Linzer and earned a degree in the instrument from the Juilliard School.
