Museum displays works of Saarinen and James Booth

If you're looking for variety in contemporary art, then the Crambrook Academy of Art Museum is the place to visit.

Now through Oct. 30, the museum is hesting an exhibition of works by Ellel Saarinen, entitled "Saarinen and Kingswood Schools." The museum also is exhibiting the works of James Scripps Booth through Dec.

ALSO INCLUDED are two large models of the schools, created for an enhibition. "Design in America: The Cranbrook Vision, 1925-1950," which were displayed at the Detroil Institute of Arts, the Metropolitan Muserum of Art and the Soomen Tridetcollsuusyhditys in Helsinki.

Already a leading architect in his native Finland, Saarinen (1873-1950) traveled to the United States in 1923 as the result of his second-place prize entry for the Cheago Tribue Tower competition.


In 1925, he was commissioned by George G. Booth to develop plans for The Cranbrook Educational Community, including Cranbrook School.

With its references to medieval architecture and borrowings from numerous European sources, the school for boys must be viewed within the context of Saariners' Finnish National Romantic architecture, an architecture which sought to create a national identity through indigenous architectural forms.

Between 1912 and his death in 1954, Booth produced hundreds of pastel landscapes, portraits and fig-ure studies. Constantly experiment-ing, his working styles included aca-demic, cariceture and impression-ism.

A SMALL pastel, entitled "Scene at Cannes, France," featured in the exhibit, is a riot of gestural line and color. A large untitled piece of a nude woman swimming illustrates Booth's predilection for an impres-

Also included in the exhibition are eight works from two of Booth's most important commissions. One of these commissions resulted in an im-

portant series of pastel drawings of the early Detroit News Shelby Street plant. The second commission features a variety of early scenes at Cranbrook.
