The Lyric Chamber Ensemble, founded by Fedora Horowits in 1980, has grown tremendously in terms of scope and impact on the community. The talent and perseverance of planist Horowitz were instrumental in

Presently, the LCE is a major lo-cal chamber group, outlasting some of its fierce competitors. Its opening program at Orchestra Hall attracted a large audience.

They were an early Divertimento by Haydn, the popular "Carnival of the Animals" by Saint Saens and the Concerts for Violin, Plano and String Quartet by Chausson.

THE ENSEMBLE, consisting mostly of Detroit Symphony musicians, presented even the lighter portions of this program with high professional skill and integrity, a special guest on the program was state Sen. Jack Faxon, who was the narrator for the Saint Saens work.

"Carnival of the Animals," a satire, was never taken too aertously even by the composer, who didn't allow its public performance during his lifetime. The narrated text, which makes fun of the composer's name, is a more contemporary ingredient.

Faxon enhanced the merry text with a humorous accent. The one drawback, however, was the lack of a microphone. It is often wrongly as-

sumed that the superb acoustics of Orchestra Hall and the carrying voice of the speaker render a micro-phone obsolete. But this hall is too big for an unampilified human voice, even if it-happens to be Fazor's. I beard com-ments on that after the performance and I missed several of the punch-lines myself, even though I've heard this text below.

ON THE bright, side, planists Horowitz and Joseph Gurt were im-pressive and accurate in their fast passages. Moreover, this was one oc-casion for them to demonstrate to plano students the importance of playing scales.

The "Svan Song," so apily played by cellist Marcy Chanteaux, was definitely not her own — she still has a long carcer ahead of her.

Violinist Stacy Woolley was impressive in his solo in Chausson's work. Horowitz, at the plano, demonstrated again her substantial strengths. This work, heavily influenced by Franck and Faure, gives the violin the dominant role and relegates the plano to background passages much of the time.

While this work may not be a masterpiece on an absolute scale, this performance showed that it nevertheless has enough charm and merits to be occasionally performed.
