## Roberta Peters sings up a storm

One may wait a long time to hear some celebrated opera star. But, at the saying goes, when it rains, it pours. Following a recital by Leontyne Price, area residents had a chance to hear soprano Roberta Peters. The program, at Temple Israel of West Bloomfield, was the opener of a rewarding series at this location.

While the traditional operatic repertoire is her favorite, it is but one of her areas of expertise.

Arias by Donizetti, Verdi and Rossini made up the first part of the program. Lighter selections by Coward, Aubert and Lehár followed. Her voice remains impressive even after decades of constant singing.

While there was an occasional excessive vibrato and some imperfect
