

Community center sporting new outdoor theater, name

president Larry Freedman said. "No one has been able to muster up the enthusiasm and fund for this center like Ben."

The center's new outdoor amphitheater also was unveiled at the reception. The amphitheater is the first of many projects to be financed with proceeds from the capital fund drive.

"We want to express our thanks and appreciation to those of you who contributed to our capital campaign," Pfaff told business leaders.

DESIGNED BY board vice president architect Leon Kohls, the amphitheater boasts a covered stage with two rooms for dressing and storage. It's equipped with track lighting with plans for sound and lighting systems to be installed. New steps leading to the amphitheater have been completed and lighting and landscaping are expected to be done by spring.

The amphitheater plays a key role in the center's new identity as a cultural center featuring light jazz and classical concerts, children's and family shows and Broadway-type plays, Pfaff said.



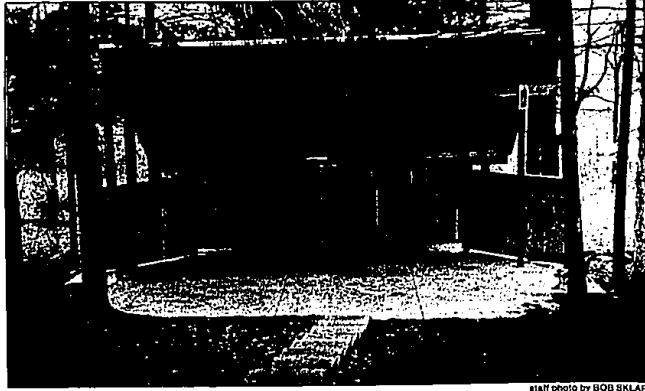

Important in the new name is that the public understands that the center is not supported by the cities of Farmington or Farmington Hills, Freedman said. The former name, Farmington Community Center, "suggested that we were funded and

supported by the city, and this inhibited us from acquiring the needed funding from corporate and private donations," according to a center announcement.

Center officials also wanted a new name because the Farmington Community Center is in Farmington Hills.
