Passage of Proposal C on the Nov. shallot would make \$5 million to \$10 million available to counties and cities for composting programs.

Composting allows leaves and other organic material to decompose under natural conditions. A rich soil conditioner that can be used as garden mulch results.

CITIES ALREADY are finding a demand for composted leaves. Gary Hubler, a street mainte-nance supervisor for Ann Arbor, said the city collects 24,000 cubic yards

of leaves a year and gives them to horticulturalists and the University of Michigan Boaniacal Gardens.
Livonia vacuum trucks pick up 46,000 cubic yards of leaves a year and take them to a landfill used only for leaves, said Charles Hopps, Livonia roads supervisor.

"Most people look at leaves like other garbage — out of sight, out of mind," said Gary Schocke, Bruce Township supervisor and chairman of the Macomb County Solid Waste Task Porce Commission. The task force is developing a composting plan for the county."
