The president of the State Bar of Michigan worries when voters pick judges on the basis of Irish names, but he wouldn't shift to appointing

judges.
"We have been very fortunate in this state that this capacity for known, identifiable names to get elected meant, in most instances, that some very qualified people were elected," said Donald L. Reisig.

"I have viewed this issue, over the
years, with some concern. My name
is Reisig - not a highly recognizable
name," said the 53-year-old former

"I sound like a lawyer — and I am
— but the first suggestion I would
make is ask your own lawyer. We
know their work ethic. We know
their habits. We know their capacity
for thought, whether or not they are
scoundrels," he replied.
