

# Science 'honor roll' names 5

Five area residents are among 29 educators, business people and private citizens recently given Honor Roll Awards for their contributions to education, science and technology.

The awards were given by several state agencies and the private-sector Michigan Technology Council.

The winners were selected from 200 nominees. They were honored April 24 at a ceremony hosted by Oakland University in Rochester.

Michigan Gov. James Blanchard said, "Science and technology play an increasingly important role in everyone's life." He commended the winners for "making a real difference in the lives of young people in Michigan."

Local winners were:  
 • Michael Piarro, the chairman of Birmingham Public Schools' Industrial Arts/Technology program.

He created a unique curriculum for the school system that simulates automation in modern industry, giving students hands-on experiences. The program is closely integrated with the industrial and technical community from beyond the school.

• Douglas Cooper, the science coordinator for the Farmington Public Schools. In nearly 20 years of classroom experience and another decade as an administrator, Cooper initiated the student Water Testing Program, River Rouge Watershed Council and developed the district's Science Resource Center and Environmental Education Center.

• Robert Richardson, vice president of Jervis B. Webb Co. of Farmington Hills, who served as 1988-89


board president of the Science and Engineering Fair of Metropolitan Detroit. Through his encouragement and leadership, the Webb company provided much support and many volunteers, to Detroit area schools through the Engineering Society of Detroit Civic Affairs Speakers Bureau.

• William K. Kumbler of Livonia, a retired science consultant with more than 30 years experience in science and teaching. He takes his knowledge on the road to elementary schools throughout southeast Michigan using 25 classroom kits which stimulate children's natural curiosity and interest in science, making them familiar and comfortable with science so that, as they grow older, they aren't afraid to pursue higher education in those fields.

• Don Dowty of Troy, an employee of U.S.S., a division of U.S.X. He initiated and currently directs a task force that is creating educational programs with automotive design schools. The goal is to foster better understanding and utilization of sheet metal steels to benefit design and safety while reducing manufacturing costs, and eventually making North American auto and steel industries more competitive.

The awards were part of events during "National Science and Technology Week," which was sponsored by the National Science Foundation. Other events included Michigan firms hosting local students. Host companies included Dow, Ford, General Motors and Masco.
