## Hills resident honored by Brighton hospital

Ken McQuillan of Farmington Hills was among 33 volunteers honored by Brighton Hospital at a dinner at the hospital April 13 in observance of National Volunteer Week.

The hospital specializes in treating and preventing substance abuse and has become nationally recognized for its programs after almost 40 years of work in this field.

The purpose of the dinner was to call attention to the important role the volunteers play in the work of Brighton Hospital and to thank them for their help. The dinner was also an opportunity for the volunteers to get to know each other and to learn the many ways they are contributing to the hospital.

During the dinner, the head of the department in which each volunteer works introduced that person and explained briefly the importance of his or her contribution to the department and to the hospital.

McQuillan helps with the Children's Support Group, a program offered by the Counseling Services Department.

"Volunteers have played an extremely important role in our work for almost four decades," said Ivan Harner, the hospital's president, at the dinner. "We depend on them in almost every aspect of our work and truly appreciate their interest, enthusiasm and commitment."

Harner noted that volunteers will be needed even more as the hospital expands its services with the opening of the Adolescent Center this fall. The new 20-bed center is being built on the eastern edge of the hospital's 69-acre campus. It will treat chemically dependent youths between the ages of 12 and 17. Like the hospital's adult patients, they will be drawn from throughout southeast Michigan.


