Everyone knows that teachers should be professional. It is well to remind ourselves of this fact when strikes abound so cleverly disguised as "no contract, no work" statements.

There seems to be no end to the insidious manner in which teachers can abort logic. During such times as these both the teachers and the public should examine the nature of professionalism.

## May To Head Fisher Body PR, Advertising

## Snowmobile Registration Will Start

For the first time in Michigan history, snowmobiles will be registered in the state.

Secretary of State James M. Harre said registration will start "sometime in October" and that his department was presently readying the "mechanics" of the registration program for the winter vehicles, which he estimates number from 50,000 to 100,000 in the state.

Based on a three-year registration cycle starting in 1969 and ending in 1971, fees are \$5 for three years; \$3 for two years; and \$2 for one year.
