RAIL TOUR
 Celebration of the fruits of Michigan vineyards will open the autumn rail excursion season. The Wine Festival Express will carry ex-

curtionists from Birmingham, Pontiac, Holly, Durand and Lansing to Kalamazoo, a one-day round-trip, Saturday, Sept. 9, to mark the Kalamazoo-Paw Paw "Wine and Harvest Festival."

Shuttle buses will enable passengers to tour operating wineries in Paw Paw. The train will be powered by Grand Trunk Western Railroad diesel-electric locomotives over the company's Holly subdivision to Durand, Toronto-Chicago main line from Durand to Pavillion and freight-only Kalamazoo subdivision into downtown Kalamazoo. Adult coach fare is \$59 (\$39, Lansing) and the fare for children, ages 5-16, is \$19 (\$14, Lansing). First class, Superdome and Golden Tower fares and services are available on request.
