AMUSEMENT TICKETS
Tickets for your favorite amusement park can be purchased at a discounted rate at the recreation division. If you are going to Bob-Lo, Cedar Point, Detroit Zoo, Four Bears Water Park, Greenfield Village, Kings Island, Sea World, Great America, Geauga Lake or Crossroads Village, stop and see us first.

CONCERT SERIES
Bring lawn chairs or blankets to enjoy the show of shows with the sounds of big bands, jazz and contemporary music. The next concert in the series will feature the Oakland

County Parks and Recreation Broadway Review today at 7:30 p.m. There is no fee for this program, held at Heritage Park.

OPEN SWIM
Our open swim program runs Mondays through Thursdays until July 27 at Harrison High School, on 12 Mile, east of Orchard Lake Road. The pool is open from 2-5 p.m. and the fee is \$1 for all ages. Children whose chin height is below 38 inches must be accompanied by a parent.

KNOW INSECTS
Collect samples of insects and learn to identify them. You will be provided with identification guides and sweep nets. "Get to Know Your Insects" will be held at Heritage Park's Spicer House from 7-9 p.m. Wednesday, July 19. Fee is \$3 a person or \$10 a family (four or more).

TENNIS TOURNAMENT
Put your skills to the test in the 14th annual Founders Festival Tennis Tournament. Matches begin Thursday, July 13, and run through the rest of the week with finals on Sunday, July 16. The tournament is open to all tennis players of amateur standing.

Divisions include junior singles, boys and girls 14 and under; teen singles, boys and girls 16 and under; adult singles; women's 35 and over; men's open; men's 45 and over; men's/women's and mixed doubles. Entry fee is \$3 for juniors and teens, \$6 for adults and \$10 for doubles. All matches will be played at Oakland Community College. To enter, apply at the recreation office. All entries must be received by Friday, July 7, at 4:30 p.m.

LEARN TO SWIM
Swimming instruction for beginner to advanced skill levels is offered at Harrison High School. The two-week instructional session from July 17-27 consists of classes that meet Monday through Thursday. All

children must be 38 inches at chin height in order to participate in swim lessons. Registration for all sessions is taken at the recreation office from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Pre-registration is necessary and handled on a first come-first served basis.

ART FAIR
The Ann Arbor Art Fair is nationally recognized as one of the best of its kind in the country. Once there, you will see why.

The streets and sidewalks are festooned with crafts, entertainment, exhibits and a wondrous representation of art of all kinds. The bus departs at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, July 19, and returns at 6:30 p.m. Registration fee is \$8 and the deadline to register is Friday, July 14.

SAFETY TOWN
Safety town is a school education program where children learn everyday safety tips through actual

participation and demonstration. Instruction includes pedestrian, motorist, bus, fire playground and bicycle safety. Children are also alerted to proper behavior with strangers and how to say no to drugs.

Movies, songs, a bus trip to the fire department and practice training all help the child enjoy and understand what he or she is learning. Farmington Hills Safety Town is a 20-hour course (two hours a day, five days a week for two weeks), designed especially for children entering kindergarten this fall. 4- to 6-year-olds will be accepted. No child under the age of 4 may be enrolled in this program.

This program is held at Alameda School (Alameda and Power); sessions available are July 10-21 from 1-3 p.m. and July 24 to Aug. 4 from 1-3 p.m. Fee is \$45 and includes a T-shirt and certificate. Pre-registration is required and is on a first-come, first-served basis.
