Leafhoppers — Invisible insects of the meadows

WHEN A person looks out over a meadow in southeastern Michigan, the beautiful summer wildflowers mirror a rainbow, spider webs reflect the morning dew, and the wind waves the whispering grass. Even from the surface, a meadow is a grand place to view.

Leafloppers are invisible until you walk through the grasses. Then like kernels of corn, they pop in presion in all possible directions. They are not much bigger than a kernel of popcorn either. When you examine one that has landed on your pantleg it will be about a quarter-inel long.

One species, the red-banded leaf-hopper, is blue and red striped. Particularly striking when seen, their



beauty often goes unsolteed.
Before it moves away, examine thow the wings are held over the back in a tent-like manner. Then, once you have satisfied your curiosity, induce it to jump by gentity nudging the tail with your finger. In an instant, the leafhopper has rocketed from its launch pant a distance of 12 inches. A 6-foot man would have to jump the distance of a football field to span an equivalent distances.

Some leafhoppers travel even greater distances in order to find food during the summer. When the adults become active after their winter dormancy, they may fly 150 miles north to find additional food uring the summer, when the winter dormancy, they may fly 150 miles north in find additional food warmer winter weather.


