ca the Beautiful." "Nobody Knows the Trouble I've Seen" "Oh, Susanna" or "I've Been Working on the Railroad" in the background. If someone painted these pictures today, it would be corny, maybe it was when he did them, but they survive and flourish, corn can be life-giving.


THOUGH BENTON documents with a close to narrator/narrator point of view, he's better than that. His highly refined style developed as he searched for the most effective way to respond to what he saw on his travels around the country. The long, fluid lines and rolling curves, the careful composition and sense of design all were honed to a fine edge.

In the first part of the exhibition are Benton's paintings before he had

found his strong, individual style. No doubt about his talent, but he still had to shake off the influence of Europeans such as Cezanne and Manet, the cubists and the impressionists to become more than a very good imitator.

When he finds himself (it started to happen when he was living in Chalmers on Martha's Vineyard), his life commitment to art, seems to be restated in each painting. The bravado style shouts over and over — This is what I do. This is who I am. Take it or leave it.

The exhibit is open 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday-Sunday. Tickets are \$3 for adults, students and seniors, children under 12 and Founders members are free. Organized student groups, with advanced appointments, are admitted free.
