In 1946, the Sales Tax Diversion Amendment was passed. This constitutional amendment established a formula for allocating sales tax revenue.

Proposal A would increase the sale tax from 4 cents to 4.5 cents. This would generate an additional

revenues and obligations transferred to the newly-created SAFE fund. Net lottery revenue and interest earned on net lottery revenues; 60 percent of the existing 4 percent sales tax, the 2 percent additional sales and use tax, and portions of the cigarette tax, the liquor tax and certain taxes levied in lieu of property taxes would be constitutionally dedicated to the SAFE fund.

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
