

Bank sets art competition

The Bank of Commerce is inviting Michigan artists to enter its sirth art competition.

As in the preceeding competitions, Heritage '89 is open to artists 18 years of age or older, Heritage '89 welcomes works in two dimensional media submitted by Friday, Oct. 20.

"Once again we are asking our artists to reflect on our state's ethnic roots and beritage," said David J. Harris, Bank of Commerce president, "We are proud to continue this unique and productive program that has attracted and benefitted so many fine Michigan artists."

The bank has acquired more than 30 artworks in the five previous contests started in 1991 and displays them in several branch offices.

The five most popular paintings were reproduced as lithographs and have been offered to the public since 1997.

In Heritage '89, a process of silder review will be used to solect 40 works, which will then be evaluated in their original form.

Elighteen finalists will be chosen and invited to


