In the past, I've written about the importance of making photographs — not just taking anaphota. Today I'd like to discuss one of the very important ingredients in the recipe of making strong photographs — developing pattence.

Developing a sense of pattence in photography can not only offer a welcome break from the turbolent pace of every day life, but it will reward you with more impact-filled pictures.

How do you develop photo-related patience? For starters, slow down and study your subject carefully and theroughly.

Let's use the approaching fail color change as an example. You've just driven out to the country and discovered a cluster of trees that are exploding with magnificient colors. Wall, don't snap that picture yet. Remember, we're nurturing a sense of patience. Start by really looking at those trees. Walk around them, get to know them and begin to get a feeling of the way they're being lit.

Ask yourself some questions. Would a different time of day improve the picture? Should I move in close or remain further back? Would a low or high vantage point make a difference? 
