More than 3,000 pint-sized ghosts, goblins and ghouls haunted the halls of Botsford General Hospital Sunday when the Farmington Hills hospital hosted its fifth annual community Halloween party.

## Officer nearly run over after chase

- fleeing and eluding, a one-year misdemeanor.
- reckless driving, a 90-day misdemeanor.
- failure to report an accident, a 90-day misdemeanor.
- operating under the influence of liquor, a 90-day misdemeanor.

Moore was released after posting \$500, or 10 percent, of the \$5,000 cash bond set by Phene.

POLICE IN Farmington and Farmington Hills gave this account of what preceded Moore's arrest:

At 8:50 p.m. Saturday, Cantlon went to Chatham Hills Apartments on Grand River to take a hit-and-run accident report.

A witness reported that a car had backed up into a garage door, causing the door to fall on a car parked inside.

While talking to Cantlon, the witness pointed out the hit-and-run car, a Probe, which was leaving the apartment complex.

Cantlon, uniformed and in a marked car, drove after the driver east on Grand River. When Cantlon activated his emergency equipment, the driver turned off his headlights and sped up.

The Probe ran a red light as it turned north on Drake. It then ran a few stop signs at a high rate of speed.

At Howard, the driver tried to turn left, but lost control. The car spun around, hit a curb and lost a

back wheel.

CANTLON STOPPED 1½-2 car lengths away and ordered the driver out at gunpoint. Instead, the driver accelerated toward the officer.

After hitting the patrol car, the driver headed north on Drake, run-

ning red lights at 12 and 13 Mile. He stopped only after hitting a tree on Dewberry, east of Drake, north of 13 Mile.

The driver was taken by ambulance to Providence Hospital, Novi, where he was treated for facial cuts.

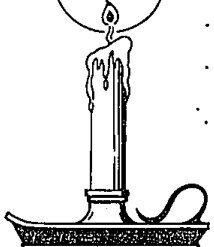
