HERMAN MILLER EXHIBIT

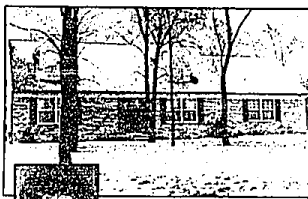
