Capture your house on canvas

(AP) — House portraits have long been the province of the upper crust, but laterest among middle-income Americans is creating a growth industry for artists and designers.

Today, dwellings ranging from mansions to mobile homes are being memortalized in ells, acrylics or water colors, in pen and ink drawings, sepla photographs, needlepoint wall hangings, hooked rugs, wood models and miniature shadow-box constructions.

Cost often is determined by the degree of the artist's involvement — from copying a mailed photograph to making a personal visit and con-ducting extensive interviews with a family and its friends.

By mall order, a photo of your home can be reproduced on an eightlinch oval ceramic plaque for \$31s. Including postage. You can opt for a custom hooked rug of your home and grounds – for \$75 a square foot. An electrified dollhouse set in an antique printer's type tray starts at \$3,500, and a house portrait by a rec-

Patricia Shiland of New York,
who does what she calls miniature who does what she calls miniature lifestyle portraits in dollhouse form, can spend up to 120 hours on one of her constructions. She does exhaustive studies of the home's history and the owner's interests and lifestyle before she begins her portraits.

THE APPEAL of these personal-THE APPEAL of these personal-ized pieces is the personal aspect, says David Bradstreet Wiggins of Tition, NH. This painter, decorator and antiques dealer travels from state to state painting murals incor-porating exterior views of a home on interior walls. He also will depict a home on a Ifreplace accessory known as a firebaard. "People want their family history and their property exterior in the picture," he says. "They want their children included and lots of roman-tic allusions – sunsets and secrets,

"You rarely get a superb house," says Barbara Goldstone, the shop's co-owner. "In fact, we just did some-body's trailer. So it is not that it's a special house, but that it is their house."

"Anyone who has put time and effort into a home will at some point have a representation of it," says Rachel Newman, editor of Country Living.

White Newman sees house portraits riding a creat of popularity to-day, Robert Bishop, director of the Museum of American Folk Art in New York, asys it's nothing new. 


