Sever wants to stay as mayor

Councilman Aldo Vagnozzi last week said if tradition is followed, he expects Fox to be elected mayor and he mayor pro tem. Vagnozzi is the next longest-serving mayor who has never served as an officer.

THE CITY charter does not specify the length of the mayor's term. But a precedent was set 18 years ago when the city's first mayor, Robert McConnell, served one year and was replaced by mayor pro tem Frederick Lichtman.

"It was open-ended. It (length of term) wasn't really discussed (when the charter was written)," former councilwoman and charter commis-sioner Joan Dudley said.
