Other tips from the Postal Service:
All packages should be cushioned
within a larger mailing container,
which is then wrapped in heavy brown
paper. Colorful tissue paper or shredded mylar can provide interesting
machiciping.

Packages should be sealed with filament reinforced—tape—rather—than twine, which can get caught in mail processing equipment. Stationers and post offices carry this tape.

Markings should be written in indelible ink, large and clear enough to be read from am's length. This doesn't mean the indelible ink can't be neon pink or red and green.

American Greetings last year introduced the Mailing Center, a line of packing and mailing items marketed through stationers and gift shops.
