**Keep approach to mailbox clear of snow**

Farmington postmaster Kenneth Harris reminds all customers that postal regulations regarding delivery of mail routes require customers to keep the approach to their mailbox cleared of snow.

This will permit the carrier to drive up to the mailbox to deposit and to collect mail without leaving his vehicle.

The approach to and the exit from the mailbox should be cleared sufficiently on both sides to allow the carrier to drive ahead and not be required to back up his vehicle after delivery.

Failure to open approaches to boxes promptly after heavy snows may temporarily prevent carriers from making deliveries. Harris said postal regulations also require that walks, steps, and porches be kept cleared of snow and ice.

"Your cooperation in these matters during the winter season will be sincerely appreciated," Harris said.
