OU offers tests preparation

The Division of Continuing Education at Oakland University has a promise for students who enroll in workshops to prepare them for tests such as the Law School Admissions Test, or L.S.A.T.: Achieve your desired test score or retake the same workshop once without charge.

The workshops are taught by college instructors who have special training in preparing students for standardized tests. They provide insight to the kinds of questions on the exams and timed practice tests.

The following is a schedule of test preparation workshops being offered:

- Three sessions of the G.M.A.T. workshop will be from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Jan. 6, 13 and 20. Tuition is

\$150, with the next test being administered on Jan. 27.

- Four sessions of the G.R.E. workshop will be held from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on Jan. 6. They will be held from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Jan. 13, 20 and 27. Tuition is \$125. The next G.R.E. exam is Feb. 3.

- An optional math refresher course for the G.M.A.T. and G.R.E. will be offered from 6 to 10 p.m. today. Tuition is \$45.

- Six sessions of the L.S.A.T. workshops will be held from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays from Jan. 23 to Feb. 8. Tuition is \$175. The next L.S.A.T. is Feb. 10.

- Three sessions of the A.C.T. workshop will be held from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Jan. 20 and 27, and from 9 a.m. to noon on Feb. 3. Tuition is \$85. The next A.C.T. exam is Feb. 10.

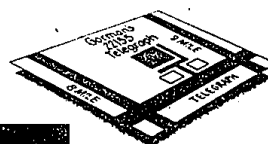
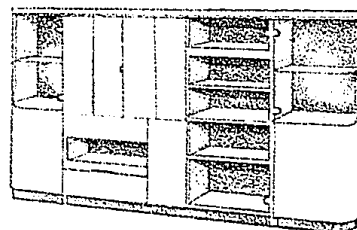
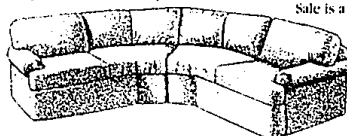
