## 3 seriously hurt in car-truck collision

the crash, said Sgt. Ray Cranston, Farmington Hills Police Department Traffic Section supervisor.

The truck, which included a 1989 Ford cab registered to Kubach Carriage Inc., Southgate, was hauling a partial load of manufacturing parts. It didn't appear to be exceeding the speed limit, Cranston said. The trucking company had no comment Wednesday.

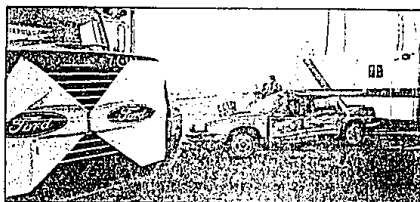
FARMINGTON HILLS police ordered the truck held at Hadley Towing & Recovery so that the Michigan State Police Motor Carrier Division could inspect it.

"Anytime we have a serious accident involving a truck, we call the Motor Carrier Division in," Cranston said.

State inspectors Wednesday checked the truck's weight, mechanical functions and paperwork. The truck sustained minimal front-end damage, Cranston said.

Farmington Hills firefighters removed the three victims from the car. Firefighter Larry Henderson assisted Community EMS paramedics in treating the injured en route to the hospital, District Fire Chief Bob Rebley said.

Farmington Department of Public Safety officers assisted Farmington Hills police with traffic control.
