Snow, ice must be cleared in Hills

Farmington Hills zoning officers know that a snow or ice storm may be just around the corner and urge you to observe the snow and ice removal ordinance in the city code.

It reads: "If any occupant or owner shall neglect or fail to clear snow and ice from the sidewalk adjoining his or her premises for a pe-

riod of 24 consecutive hours or more, such person shall be guilty of a violation of this article.

"In addition, the city manager or the city manager's designee may cause such sidewalk to be cleared and the expense of clearing shall become a debt to the city from the oc-

cupant or owner of such premises and shall be collected as a single lot assessment."

Violators are responsible for a civil infraction and must pay a fine not to exceed \$500. Each day a violation exists may be considered a separate violation and a fine so imposed.

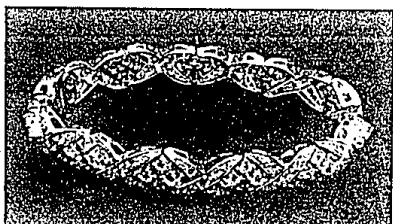
