Hills man charged with beating tot

A Farmington Hills man is charged with assault with intent to murder in connection with an alleged severe beating of a 7-month-oid boy he was helping care for.
Arraigned Feb. 21 before District Judge Fred Harris of Farmington, fromald Lowell Dring, 23, stood mute to the charge and an Innocent plea was entered in his behalf. Harris signed the arrest warrant the day before.
Harris adjourned Dring's prellminary exam last Wednesday at defense attorney Joseph Kosmala's request.

Dring was remanded to the Oak-land County Jall in lieu of \$250,000

iand county Jain in fee of \$250,000 cash or surety bond pending the exam, rescheduled for March 14. Harris denied Kosmala's request for personal bond but the Mount Clemens attorney said he intends to request it again if his client is bound over for trial.

"We categorically deny any mistreatment of Joshua whatsoever," Kosmala said Friday, "We're absolutely abbored that Mr. Dring has been charged in this case."

Joshua Mardin was reported in fair condition Friday at Children's Hospital of Michigan in Detroit Misspital of Michigan in Detroit is vastly improved. That's informat is vastly improved. That's information I got from the baby's mother, who seems him on a daily basis," Kosmala said.

Dring and Joshua's mother are en-gaged, Kosmala said.

WHEN COMMUNITY EMS paramedics brought him to the Bots-ford General Hospital emergency room at 3 p.m. Feb. 8, Joshua had nock bruises along the Jawiline as well as his left arm and shoulder. He also had broken blood vessels in the left ear. He was unconscious and began having scieures, Farmington Hills police sald.

The attending physicians determined the most serious injury was a life-threatening internal head injury. At 5:15 p.m. Feb. 8, Joshua was transferred to Children's Hospital, willow gold.

"We deny the bruises were the result of any striking or bitting." Kosmala said. "They were the result of the baby having been dropped accidentally."

Dring accidentally dropped Joshua from shoulder height while picking him up after lying him on a bed so he could play with him for a few moments, Kosmala sald. Dring had moved the 25-pound baby to the bed in an effort to comfort him after he awoke, crying, in another room, Kosmala sald.

"The baby lurched backwards and fell to the carpeted cement floor," he

felt to the curports said.

"My investigation would reveal that everything is consistent with having happened exactly as Mr. Dring said it happened," Kosmala added,

Their four birth children are Ryan, 27, Rence, 25; Kevin, 23, and Annette, 21.

When Illsha was adopted by the Faulkners, she said, "Now I'm a human being," Donna recalled.

"I guess she didn't feel like she be-longed anywhere," Donna said. "She just wanted to be part of the family, and she really wanted our name."



One boy stands out in Donna's mind. The 14 month old had been abused and neglected. Donna raised the boy until he was 3, when the Department of Social Services decided his natural mother was fit to take him back. Three months after he was sent home, he was beaten to death by his mother's boyfriend.
